A Regular Meeting of the Grand Saline City Council will be held on April 10, 2018 in the Council Chambers, 128 E. Frank St., Grand Saline Texas,

This item allows citizens an opportunity to address the City Council on issues that are NOT on the City Council Agenda or the subject of a public hearing. Anyone wishing to speak must sign in and list the topic they wish to discuss. They will be allowed to speak for 3 minutes. If 3 or more people wish to address the same topic, a spokesperson should be chosen to represent the group. Time is limited to 3 minutes per speaker for a total of 30 minutes. Speakers should address their comments to the presiding officer. The speaker must avoid discussion of personalities and indecorous language, as well as refraining from personal attacks and verbal abuse. Complaints about individual Council members or City personnel will not be heard by the Council during the meeting. Complaints about specific individuals shall be presented in writing to the Mayor or City Administrator. Any disruptive behavior by the speaker or person in attendance at the Council meeting may cause the individual to be removed from the meeting and charged with disrupting a lawful meeting.
