Councilman Chris Barker made a motion to approve minutes of the November 10, 2015 meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilman Steve Sikes and carried unanimously.

Councilman Steve Sikes made a motion to approve financials as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilman Chris Barker and carried unanimously.

There were no public comments.


